Roots of Change Foundation - Objects

The objects of the Roots of Change Foundation are:

- 1) To advance the goals set by Pope Paul VI in his encyclical "*Populorum Progressio*" (The Development of Peoples) as follows:
 - (i) To relieve poverty in developing nations by:
 - a) providing food, clothing and shelter to persons in need;
 - b) assisting persons in need by providing self-sustaining and economic development initiatives in education, health care and agriculture; and
 - c) providing business loans to women in need in developing nations.
- 2) To advance education in developing nations by:
 - (i) building and providing schools for primary and secondary school students and providing necessary books, equipments and educational aids;
 - (ii) providing scholarships to students in need in developing nations; and
 - (iii) providing training to the poor in developing nations in farming and conservation.
- 3) To promote health in developing nations by:
 - (i) promoting and organizing physical fitness activities for children; and
 - (ii) providing and operating a medical clinic that will provide medical care to persons in need.
- 4) To gift funds to qualified donees as defined in subsection 149.1(1) of the *Income Tax Act*.
- 5) To do all other things which are incidental and ancillary to the attainment of the above objects."

These Objects where adopted by a special resolution passed March 15, 2009 and subsequently registered with CRA.
